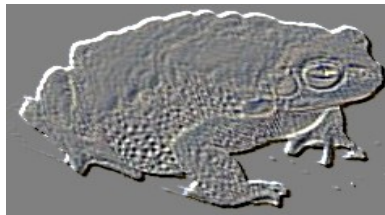

A Short Summary

ID-SS as Ong-Hok-Ham Memorial Academic Programs (OMAP)

The ID-SS (International Diaspora – Summer School) was designed as a homage to Onghokham or a **three-week study program** (short-term) which takes place in selected campuses of the insular Southeast Asia and around the Austronesian region.

The ID-SS was initiated in Europe on August 30th, 2015 by universal polyhistor, polemologist & econophenomenologist Mai Dar (Marburg University Town) as a homage to a prominent Southeast Asian historian Ong Hok Ham (1933-2007): a multi-campus, multi-disciplinary, multi-regional university system for excellence academic short term study program, which open for all international, regional & local participants (academies, professionals, politicians, government officials, non-government activists, etc.).

- **Duration:** 4 weeks (one month)
- **Program dates:** (expected, see: Upcoming 'International School' Date via: ctc.unimal.ac.id)
- **Scheduled travel days:** (expected, see: Upcoming 'International School' Date via: ctc.unimal.ac.id)

- **Participants (minimum):** approx. 20 students (minimum) in Sumatra and approx. 20 students in Java
- **Accreditation:** The ID-SS can be accredited as **8 Credit-Points**. Please see the [ID-SS Fact Sheet](#) for possible course accreditations. Please be aware that the **Credit-Points earned at the ID-SS could also be confirmed as part of "foreign experience abroad"** (Auslandserfahrung) in selected partner universities. Credit Transfer Program could give a large opportunity for related students to create their own international study experiences and earn course credits at other overseas universities.
- **Teaching methods:** lecture modules, discussions, case-studies, project work in international groups, in-class group presentations, guest lectures, etc. Participants will be able to experience different cultures and meet various background of people in the Austronesian or Southeast Asian region.
- **Course outline:** The ID-SS Course Outline will be determined by latest end of the target date and will be sent to all candidates or participants after successful online registration.

Program Fee

The ID-SS program fee will be: **1,100 EUR** (or select the alternative options with financial support, scholarship, etc., here: ctc.unimal.ac.id).

This program fee includes:

- Course fee (lectures) and course material
- Coordination costs prior and during the program
- Accommodation including breakfast (in nomadic tents, yurts, etc.)
- Coffee breaks and lunches on lecture days
- Opening and Closing Reception
- International cultural evening, outbound & excursion
- Foreign travel insurance

Flights, transfers, health insurances, extra meals on lecture and non-lecture days, extra costs on-site, vaccinations (if applicable) and visa fees are not included.

Academic Program & Certification:

Parts of the study programs are held in English; including optional programs such as Language Courses (including special auxiliary language Esperanto as lingua franca), multi-cultural programs, excursions.

Certification/Credit-Points will be awarded only by successful program participation.

This time:

ID-SS will be held mainly in Sumatra & Java, in cooperation with excellence universities, such as in Sumatra (Ar Raniry University, Malikussaleh University & Syiah Kuala University) and in Java (University of Indonesia, Paramadina University & Syarif Hidayatullah University, etc.), or other campuses or locations around Austronesian area.
