

A Short Summary

LV-DC as George Memorial Academic Programs (OMAP)

The LV-DC Loreley Valey – Diaspora College was designed as a homage to Stefen George or a "Short Term" (one till ten weeks) which takes place mainly in the UNESCO Upper Middle Rhine ("Loreley Valley") or in selected partnership campuses in Europe.

LV-DC was initiated in Europe on August 30th, 2016 by universal historian, polemologist & econophenomenologist Mai Dar (Marburg University) as a homage to a prominent writer and poet Stefan George (1868-1933): a multi-campus, multi-disciplinary, multi-regional university system for excellence academic short term study program, which open for all international, regional & local participants (academies, professionals, politicians, government officials, non-government activists, etc.).

- **Duration:** Minimum circa one week (maximum circa ten weeks);

- Participants: approx. 15 participants (minimum);
- Accreditation: The LV-DC can be accredited as part of European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

 Credit-Points earned at the LV-DC could be confirmed as part of "foreign experience abroad"
 (Auslandserfahrung) in selected partner universities. Credit Transfer Program could give a large opportunity for related students to create their own international study experiences and earn course credits at other overseas universities.
- **Teaching methods**: lecture modules, discussions, case-studies, project work in international groups, inclass group presentations, guest lectures, etc. Participants will be able to experience different cultures and meet various background of people in the World Heritage Loreley Valley or other selected European region.
- Course outline: The LV-DC Course Outline will be determined by latest end of the target date and will be sent to all candidates or participants after successful online registration.

Program Fee

The LV-DC program fee will be charged according to the selected course (or apply for the alternative options with financial support, scholarship, etc., here: more infos per email above).

- International cultural evening, outbound & excursion

Academic Program & Certification:

Parts of the study programs are held in English, part in German or other standard languages according to the availability; including special preparatory courses such as: A. International Auxiliary Language Program; B. German Language Program; C. Chrash Course Program or multi-cultural programs & excursions.

Certification / Credit-Points will be awarded by academic supervisor/professor only by successful attending program participation.

This year:

LV-DC will be held mainly in the Loreley Valley (between Bingen & Boppard in Germany), in cooperation with excellence university staffs/lecturers in Europe, such as Marburg, Mainz Mannheim and other campuses or locations around the Rhine River borders in the European Union (plus the Benelux borders).
